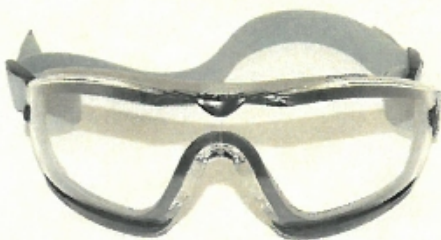

Note: The present EU type-examination certificate is the second revision of the previous EC Type-Examination Certificate issued by Certottica on 08/05/2015 with number AC 15031. The first revision, issued on 12/07/2019 converted the EC Type-Examination Certificate into an EU type-examination certificate and updated the manufacturer's address. This second revision renews the EU type-examination certificate. The eye-protector model COBRA TPR has three ocular variants: Clear - reference code COBTPRPSI (protection against optical radiation - ultraviolet filters with resistance to surface damage by fine particles and resistance to fogging), Smoke - reference code COBTPRPSF (protection against optical radiation - sunglare filters for industrial use with resistance to surface damage by fine particles and resistance to fogging) and Copper - reference code COBTPRCSP (protection against optical radiation - sunglare filters for industrial use with resistance to surface damage by fine particles and resistance to fogging).
